Academic year 2019/2020	Semester 1 : September 9 th , 2019 to January 17 th , 2020 Semester 2 : January 20 th to June 12 th , 2020
Period of arrival	Early September for a year long mobility or mid January for the second semester.
Minimum level of incoming students	ENSAB accepts students from the 2 nd undergraduate year onward.
Assessment system	Local grades : from 0 to 9.99 (fail) and from 10.00 to 20.00 (pass)
Compulsory documents	International exchange students must also provide with : + their letter of selection signed by their institution of origin + their birth certificate duly stamped, translated in French + a recent passport size photograph + a liability insurance. <u>No student without liability insurance will be allowed in the exams rooms.</u>
Accommodation	A student accommodation can be provided through ENSAB. Their number is limited. Please ask International Officer for details.
French language course	A 30 hour free of charge French language course is proposed to incoming mobility students (October to January). Validation by constant attendance.

* Several courses are not open to incoming mobility students, such as English and Law.
