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<b>Academic year 2021/2022</b>	Semester 1 * : September 13 <sup>th</sup> , 2021 to February 4 <sup>th</sup> , 2022 Semester 2 * : February 21 <sup>st</sup> to June 24 <sup>th</sup> , 2022 (* to be confirmed)
<b>Period of arrival</b>	Early September for a year long mobility or late January for the second semester.
<b>Minimum level of incoming students</b>	ENSAB accepts students from the 2 <sup>nd</sup> undergraduate year onward.
<b>Assessment system</b>	ECTS credits Local grades : from 0 to 9.99 (fail) and from 10.00 to 20.00 (pass)
<b>Deadline for applications</b>	For the whole academic year : June 30 <sup>th</sup> , 2021 For the 2 <sup>nd</sup> semester only : December 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2021
<b>Deadline for learning agreements (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester):</b>	At the start of each semester a learning agreement is established. This learning agreement must be <u>signed by both institutions at the beginning of each semester</u> to allow students' official registration to exams lists.
<b>Compulsory documents</b>	To register, Erasmus students must provide with * the letter of selection from their home university * a French language proficiency certificate at least equivalent to B1 according to CEFRL (compulsory) * the European Health Insurance Card * a passport size photograph * a liability insurance. <u>Please note that no student without insurance will be allowed in the exams rooms.</u>
<b>Accommodation</b>	A student accommodation can be provided through ENSAB. Their number is limited. Please ask Erasmus Officer for details.
<b>French language course</b>	A 30 hour free of charge French language course is usually proposed to incoming mobility students starting in October. Constant attendance is then awarded 2 ECTS. <i>Due to the pandemic, ENSAB was not able to organize it in 2020/2021.</i>
