Academic year 2020/2021	Semester 1 : September 13 <sup>th</sup> , 2021 to February 4 <sup>th</sup> , 2022 Semester 2 : February 21 <sup>st</sup> to July 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 2022
Period of arrival	Early September for a yearlong mobility or early February for the second semester
Minimum level of incoming students	ENSAB accepts students from the 2 <sup>nd</sup> undergraduate year onward.
Assessment system	Local grades : from 0 to 9.99 (fail) and from 10.00 to 20.00 (pass)
Compulsory documents	International exchange students must also provide:  + their letter of selection signed by their institution of origin  + their birth certificate duly stamped, translated in French  + a recent passport size photograph  + a liability insurance.  No student without liability insurance will be allowed in the exams rooms.
Accommodation	A student accommodation can be provided through ENSAB. Their number is limited. Please ask International Officer for details.
