## **DEADLINES FOR APPLICATION**

- Whole academic year or Fall semester: June 30th, 2022
- 2nd semester only (Spring semester): December 15th, 2022

## **IMPORTANT DATES:**

- 1st semester (Fall semester): September 12th, 2022 until February 3rd, 2022
- 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (Spring semester): February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023 until June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023
